Background :

By 2050, the agricultural food production will need to increase by 60% from now to meet the demand and most of this to come from increased productivity. About 2.4 billion people in developing countries at that time would be from South Asia and sub-Saharan Africa out of the total world population to be around 9.9 billion and India to share 1.7 billion. Raising agricultural productivity and income in small holder production system would be crucial for reducing poverty, achieving food security and act as a key driver of economic transformation and growth. Climate change has already impacted agricultural growth. According to IPCC, climate change affects crop production in several parts of the world with negative than positive effects. The developing countries are highly vulnerable to such impacts. Frequency and intensity of weather extremes such as drought, heavy rainfall, flooding and high temperatures are already occurring and expected to go further high in many regions. These effects will not, however, be evenly distributed. Water scarcity and drought are also likely to be major challenges sooner than later.

Increased Climate variability worsens production risks and the farmers' risk coping ability. Climate change is expected to influence yields by changing crop phenology, change cropping systems, pest & disease life cycles, fish life and livestock habits. Climate change poses threat to food access by reducing agricultural production and incomes, increasing risks and disrupting markets. Poor producers, the landless and marginalized ethnic groups are to face the vagaries of vulnerability. To sustainably increase the productivity, enhance climate resilience and reduce greenhouse gas emissions; adaptation to climate smart agricultural technologies, practices and services is must. Similarly, rainwater harvesting, use of improved seeds, ICT based agro-advisories, reducing post harvest losses and crop/livestock insurances can help farmers to reduce the ill effects of climate change. A meta-analysis of crop simulation under several climate scenarios found that farm level adaptations can increase crop yields by an average of 7-15%.

The climate smart agriculture in the areas of Water, Energy, Nutrient, Carbon, Weather, Knowledge, Communication, Trade and Commerce etc. would pave the way towards agricultural sufficiency and sustainability.

The aim of the 9th NEEC is to bring into focus the plausible neo-extension perspectives and horizons in Climate Smart Agricultural Technologies, Practices and Services: to identify opportunities and the best ways to diffuse the appropriate technologies, practices and services for food and income securities under progressive climate change and variability.

Themes of the Congress

1. Climate Smart farming and food and nutritional security-challenges and strategies
2. Neo-extension horizon and researches towards climate elegant agriculture
3. Innovations in farming to address biotic and abiotic stress arising due to change in climate
4. Post harvest technology, value addition, farm mechanization, nutri-sensitive interventions for women and entrepreuneuring in farming
5. Indigenous Technical Knowledge and Information and Communication Technology in climate smart farming
6. Engagement of youth in climate smart agriculture and secondary agriculture
